

2015 ALL CITY SWIM MEET SPECIAL REQUEST FROM THE HOST TEAM

We are thrilled to be hosting the All City Swim Meet and look forward to welcoming the other 12 All City teams to High Point. In an effort to give the swimmers, their families and friends the best experience possible, we are utilizing the soccer field at High Point Christian Church as Tent City. Since Tent City is not located on the High Point Swim Club property and as there is a short walk to the pool through private and city properties, we're sincerely requesting that all swimmers and visitors **respect our neighbors**.

We will need cooperation in keeping swimmers and visitors in designated areas. We will be using snow fencing and roping to indicate the proper path to use between Tent City and High Point Swim Club. Along this path, we ask everyone to please **be respectful to the residents in the condos** and to keep off of their property. **Swimmers and visitors will also not be permitted by the pond behind Tent City**. Blatant disregard of the meet boundaries will result in a disqualification of the swimmer(s) involved.

In an effort to minimize the damage to High Point Church's property, we would appreciate your support in trying to **keep the grounds as clean as possible**. There will be plenty of trash and recycle bins located in Tent City to make clean up easy. As fun as Silly String is, please ask your swimmers to refrain from bringing it to the meet. The contents of Silly String can damage the soccer field and is difficult to remove from grass.

Lastly, we ask that your families and friends abide by a few simple traffic guidelines that we have set up. Please remind all families to obey the street and traffic flow signs--we will have police officers on High Point and Old Sauk to assist with traffic and pedestrian crossings. There will be no parking on High Point Road but there will be parking in the High Point Church parking lot and the Wexford Neighborhood. Again, we request that all swimmers and visitors use the sidewalks and marked pathways to walk to High Point and Tent City. Please do not walk through our neighbor's yards. Also, we would like you to encourage your parents to use the drop off area at High Point Church (Tent City). There will be a back-up drop off area in front of High Point Swim Club on High Point Road but if parents could plan on using the drop off point at the church, it would not only help with the traffic flow but also keep everyone safer.
