



All-City 2011 Clerk of Course Information for Swimmers and Parents

In order to help things run as smoothly as possible at the upcoming All City Swim Meet we appreciate you taking a minute to read over the following Clerk of Course Information and review it with your swimmer(s). Thank You!

- All swimmers must go through Clerk of Course. Swimmers cannot go directly to the starting blocks regardless of their age.
- Only checked-in swimmers and coaches will be allowed in the clerk of course (if there are particular cases where a parent needs access to a swimmer ex. Medical reasons... please discuss this with one of the Clerk of Course directors).
- Swimmers should use the bathroom before entering Clerk of Course
- Swimmers will be expected to show respect and good sportsmanship, use a quiet voice and follow directions while in Clerk of Course
- Events will be announced over the PA and an individual will go to each tent with a bullhorn announcing events that are being staged. We strongly encourage swimmers to come on the first call to the Clerk of Course.
- Swimmers are encouraged to leave personal items at their swim team tent and NOT bring items with them to the Clerk of

Course. Team baskets will be provided outside the Clerk of Course for swimmers to deposit items while they are in Clerk of Course and swimming events. Parkcrest pool will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.

- 10 and under swimmers will NOT be allowed to take ANY personal items into the clerk of course or onto the pool deck.
- 11 and up swimmers will be allowed to take personal items into the clerk of course and onto the pool deck to be deposited into a basket behind their lane if they choose. Swimmers will be required to retrieve their items immediately following their event. Any items not immediately retrieved will be delivered to the swim meet lost and found. Swimmers will not be allowed to return to the pool deck to retrieve their items once they exit after their event.

FRIDAY RELAYS (8 & UNDER) and SATURDAY RELAYS (9 and Up):

- **New this year – “Relay Team Meeting Spot”**
 - Each team will have a designated relay team meeting spot (please talk with your coach prior to the meet about your team’s specific procedures for getting organized for relays). Teams will need to arrive at Clerk of Course with the correct 4 swimmers, in the correct order; with the correct relay card.

SATURDAY FINALS:

- Alternate swimmers should report to the Clerk of Course ready to swim. They will remain until all 18 final swimmers have checked in.
