63,000 Meals for Second Harvest All City Swim Teams Compete to Fill Neighborhood Food Pantries

Madison, August 2, 2008—Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin was a big winner during the 2008 All City Swim Meet which wrapped up today at the West Side Swim Club, 5533 Odana Road.

On one of the most beautiful days this summer, representatives of Second Harvest were on hand to hear All City Co-director Connie Chesnik announce the results of the 12 swim clubs food drive competition.

Total Dollars Raised: \$7,937.43

Total Pounds Raised: 9,012

For every \$1 donated Second Harvest provides the equivalent of seven meals.

The All City donation will provide 63,000 meals.

The West Side Swim Club won the competition collecting an amazing 201.2 pounds per swimmer. West Side is one of All City's smaller pools with 126 swimmers competing at All City this year.
