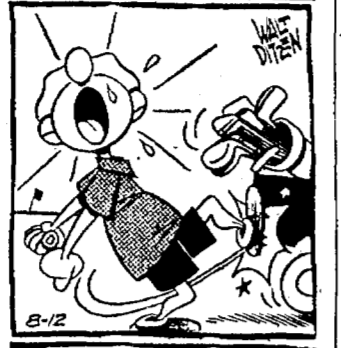
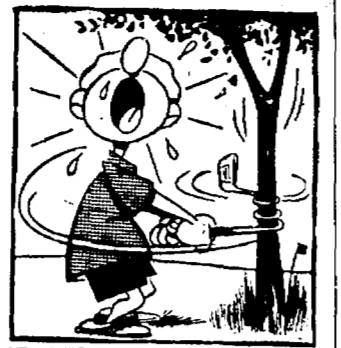

Fran 'Scrambled' a Packer Victory

GREEN BAY (AP) — "All the key plays were out and out scrambles," said Green Bay Packer Coach Phil Bengtson Saturday night after his team was upset, 15-14, by the New York Giants in a National Football League exhibition game.

And it wasn't surprising. The architect of the Giant victory was the man who put the word scramble in the sport's fan's dictionary — former Minnesota Viking Fran Tarkenton.

"ALL THE normal runs were stopped pretty well," added Bengtson, in his home debut after taking over from Vince Lombardi, now the Packer general manager. "But he (Tarkenton) did make all the key plays, no question about that."

Bengtson was referring to the first down Tarkenton picked up on the Packer six with little more than one minute to play. Tarkenton faded to pass on fourth down at the 13, with the Packers ahead, 14-9, then sprinted forward for a seven-yard gain.

TWO PLAYS later Tarkenton fired a three-yard pass over stopper Jeter to Joe Morrison for the winning touchdown in the annual Bishop's Charities game.
