M E E T I N F O R M A T I O N

- ADMISSION:** Admission will be free. HEAT SHEETS will be sold for \$1.75 each day at the entrance to the pool.
- TIME SCHEDULE:** WARM-UPS on Thursday and Friday will be from 8:30-9:45 a.m. with the meet beginning at 10:00 a.m. Saturday's warm-ups will be from 7:30-8:45 a.m. with the meet beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- CONCESSIONS:** FOOD will be sold in the tent on the grounds north of the community center. All swimmers and spectators are asked to eat on the grounds. Picnic tables will be provided. NO FOOD OR DRINK IN THE POOL AREA PLEASE. Your cooperation in following this rule and also disposing of trash in the barrels provided will be greatly appreciated.
- T-SHIRTS, PAINTERS HATS AND PATCHES will be sold in the tent located at the entrance to the pool. T-shirts - \$9.00; painter hats - \$4.00; patches - \$3.50; three piece package - \$15.00.
- FINAL RESULTS can be ordered at the Heat Sheet table for \$2.00.
- RESULTS:** Results of events as they are swum will be posted outside on the north wall of the community center.
- AWARDS:** Awards will be rosettes for the first three places and ribbons through twelfth place in all events. Heat winner ribbons will be given for all events during preliminaries and in relay events through age twelve (12).
- LOST & FOUND:** The Lost and Found is located in the check-room of the community center.
- TENT FOR SWIMMERS:** The tent for swimmers is located on the grass area west of the pool. North of the tennis courts is a tarp protected area for swimmers. All swimmers are encouraged to remain in these areas to prevent overcrowding in the pool area.
- CLERK OF COURSE:** The staging area is located upstairs in the community center.
- RESTROOMS:** Restroom facilities for swimmers and spectators are located in the parking lot west of the community center. THERE WILL BE NO ADMITTANCE TO THE POOL BUILDING EXCEPT BY MEET OFFICIALS.
- TELEPHONE:** The pay phone is located inside the door of the community center.
- It is expected that each pool club will be responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any swimmer whose conduct is harmful to others or to property will be asked to leave the meet.
